29%





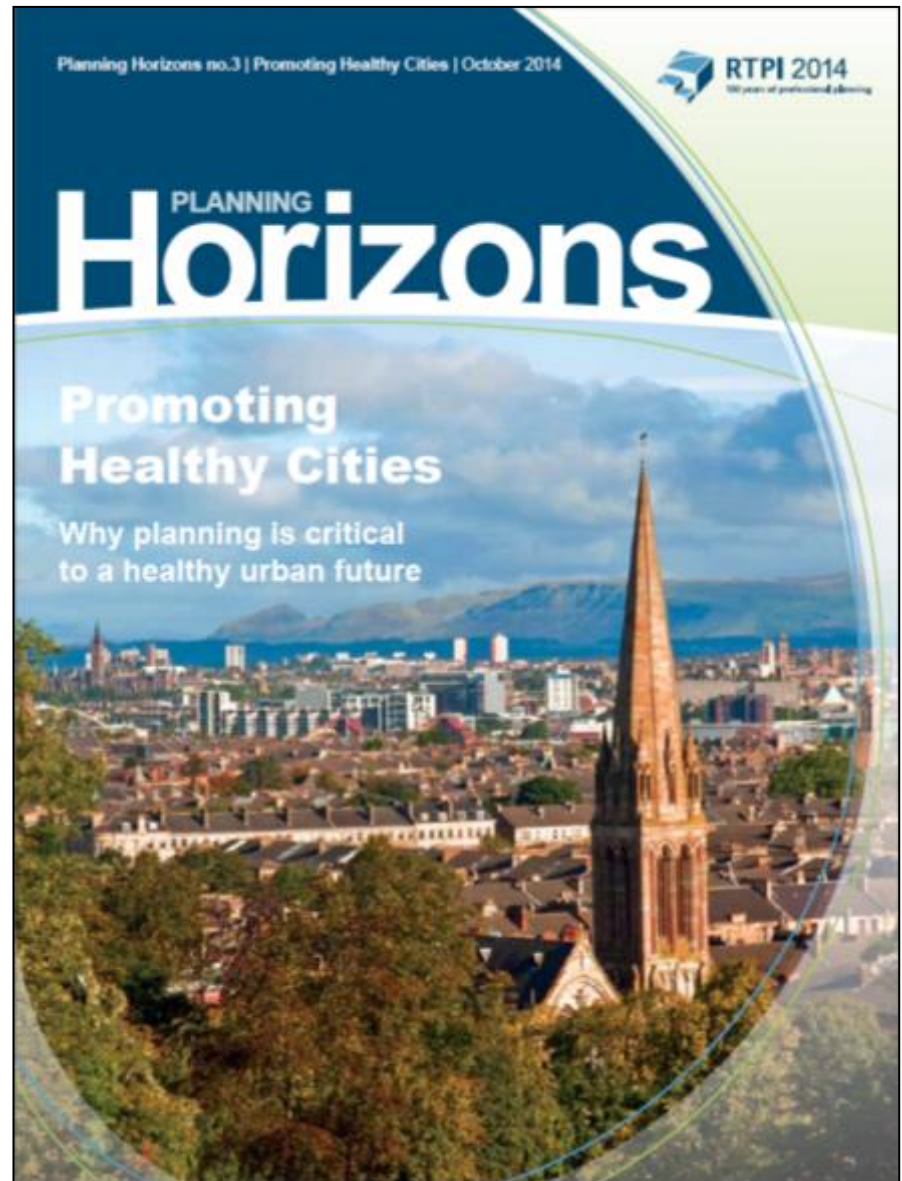

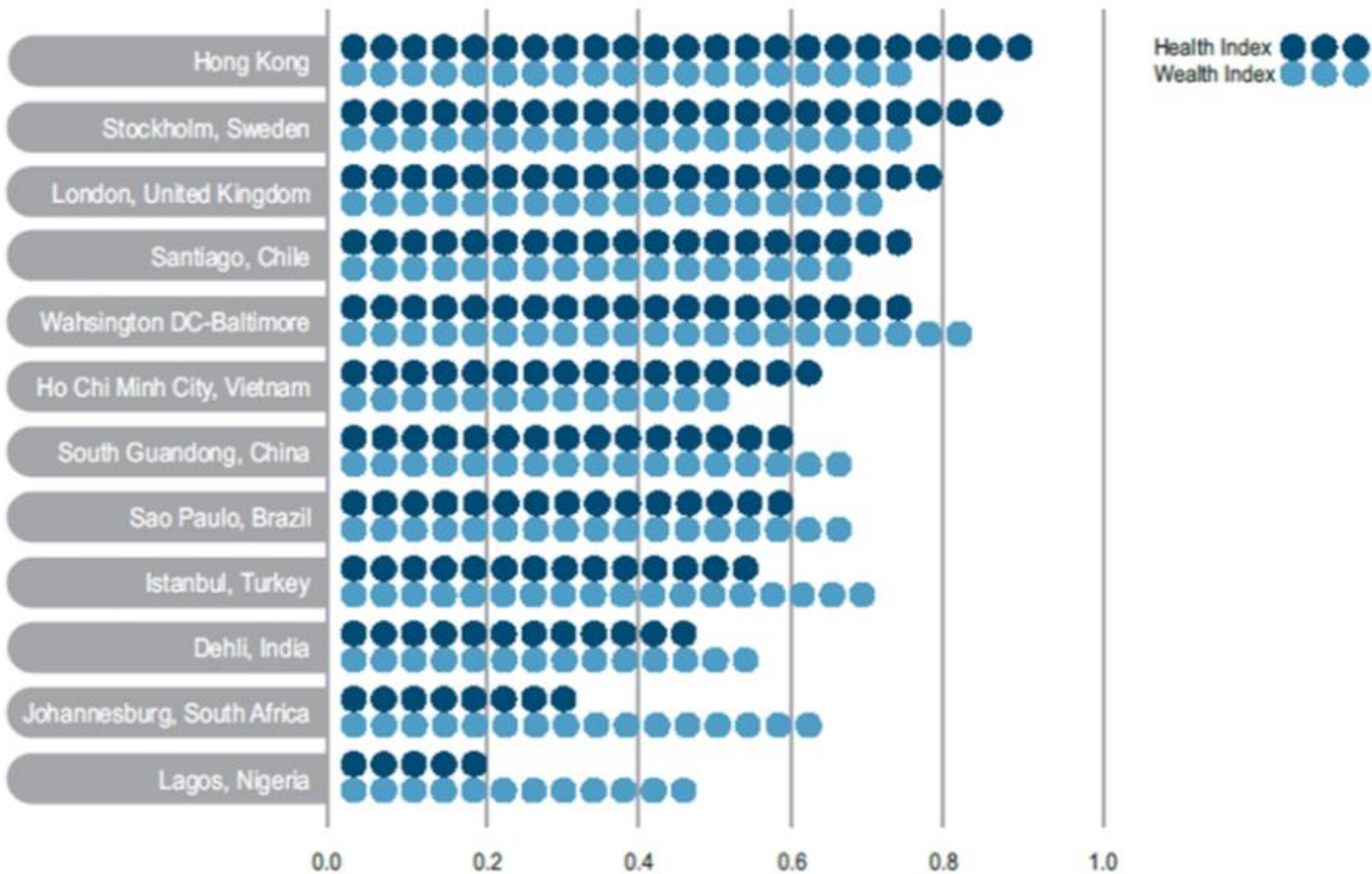
