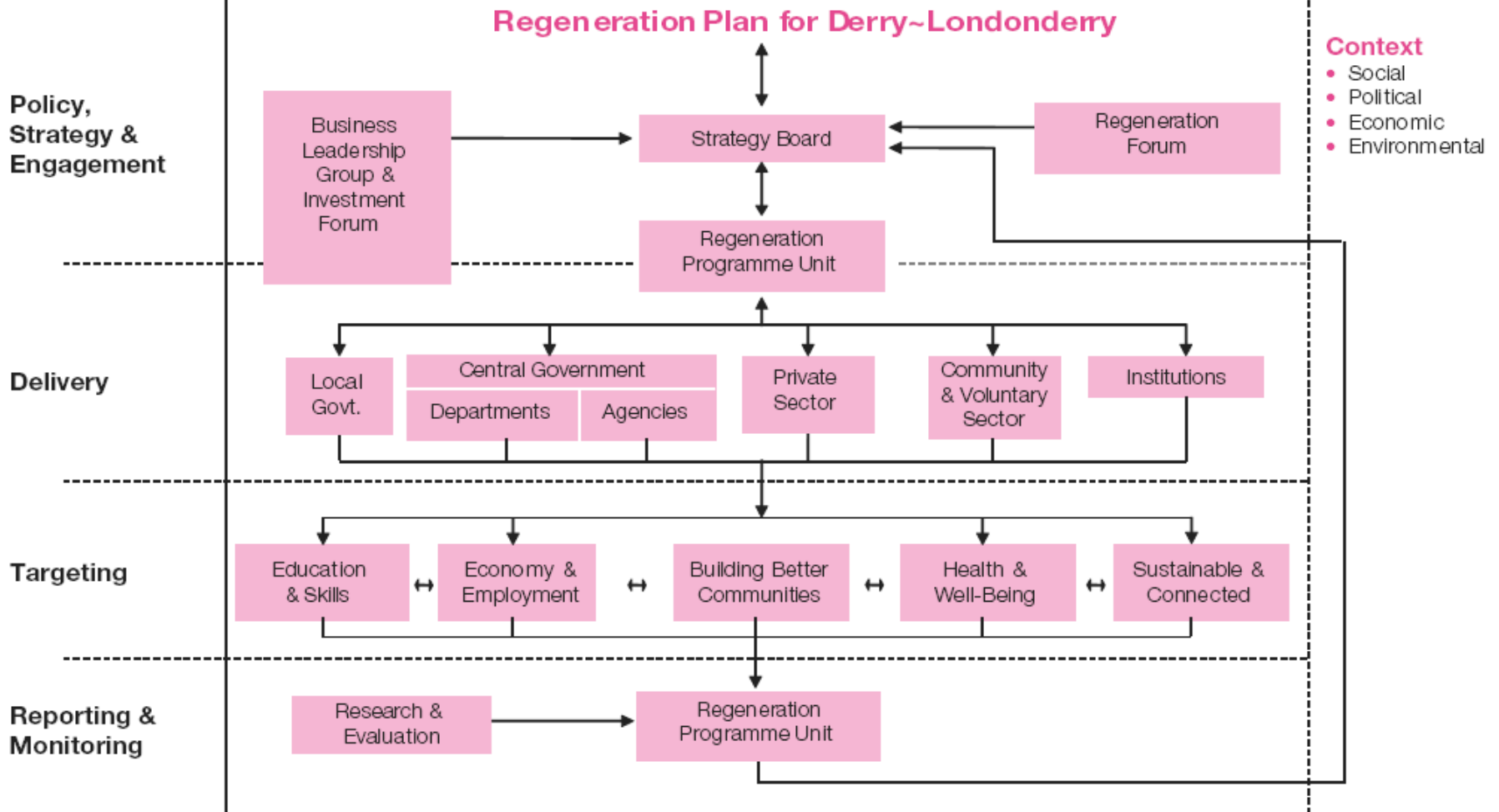

“Health and health inequalities are largely determined by factors outside the reach of the healthcare sector.”



Health and Well Being

- Dental registrations in Derry LDG are amongst the lowest in NI
 - Less than a quarter of children under 3 are registered with a dentist
(Derry LGD: 23.5%, NI: 30.3%, as low as 16.1% in *Shantallow East*)
- 1 in 3 children in Derry LGD live in Income Support households (NI:1 in 5)
- Teenage birth rate per 1,000 of female population is higher than NI average - 17 in Derry LGD (15 in NI)
- There were 779 deaths within Derry LGD in 2010
- Standardised mortality rate second highest in NI
- Outside of Belfast, Derry LGD had the highest occurrence of alcohol related deaths



The key determinants of health and wellbeing are:

- Low income
- Unemployment
- Poor environment
- Diet
- Lack of physical activity
- Smoking
- Alcohol and drug misuse
- Poor education
- Sub-standard housing



The 5 priority areas are:

1. Transform the culture of alcohol in the city
2. Promote positive more sustainable communities
3. Establish Derry-Londonderry as an active city to stop the rise in obesity
4. Promote and improve mental and emotional health and wellbeing of all age groups
5. Promote active ageing

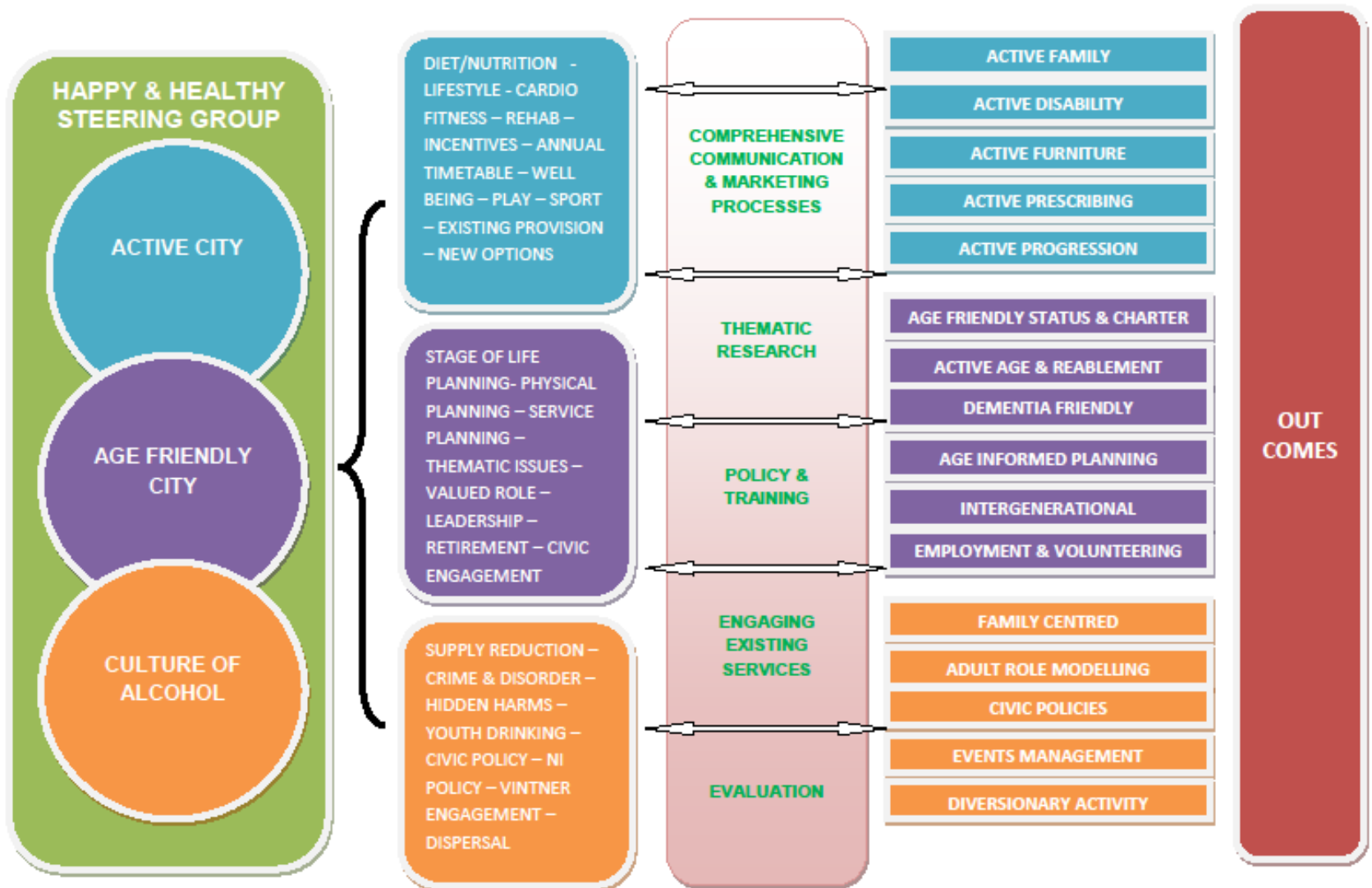
